- Manages and protects water resources
- Encompasses huge area from St. Bonifacius to south Minneapolis, including Lake Minnetonka, Mpls Chain of Lakes Minnehaha Creek, Minnehaha Falls, 8 major creeks, 129 lakes, thousands of wetlands, 27 cities.
